Patron's Message

Sanaatanadharma is said to be the path of a **structured**, **virtuous life** in sync with *rutam* (Balance of Physical, Ethical, Moral and Spiritual forces that maintain order in the Universe), from **time immemorial**, as per the **dictums** provided in *shrutis* and *smrutis* of Veda.

Sanaatanadharma means, eternal and timeless dharma. It refers to a set of values for ethics, morals, duties, and philosophical principles that are essential for the sustainability of nature, society, humanity, life after death, and principles of rebirth. Essentially in *Vedic* terms for the sustenance of four endeavors of humanity – i.e., dharma, artha, kaama and moksha (chaturvidha purushaarthaah - dharmah, arthah, kaamah & mokshah / चतुर्विधपुरुषार्थाः-धर्मः, अर्थः, कामः & मोक्षः), applicable to all four varnaas and in all four aashramas.

Basic *Vedic* dictums are: *satyam vada* (Speak only the Truth) and *dharmam cara* (Follow only what is the appropriate course); *Dharmo Rakshati Rakshitah* (Righteous path protects all its followers).

Main objectives are: vasudhaiva kutumbakam (one Global Family); sham no bhavatu dvipade sham chatushpade (harmonious living for entire humanity (dvipade) including animals (chatushpade), birds and other living organisms; adhyaatmika shaanti, aadhi bhautika shaanti and aadhi daivika shaanti (peace from internal and external sources (i.e.) natural and supernatural forces). These objectives lead to sarve janaah sukhino bhavantu (All Human beings shall be happy and comfortable).

The main application to follow for success in Life: *trikaraNa shuddhi*. (There shall be purity and uniformity in all three actions ie manasaa, *vaachaa* and *karmanaa – our thoughts, our words and our actions*).

Basic belief: *karma siddhaanta*. The results/effects experienced/perceived today (at this moment) are influenced/caused by earlier actions (in the immediate past or over a long time ago!).

Reality: Cosmic force/ *chaitanyam*/ *paramaatmaa*/ *parabrahma*/ *paramjyoti*// *shuddha chaitanyam*/ *aatmaa*, is the basis for the existence of all movable and immovable bodies in the universe (*pipeelikaadi brahmaa paryantam* - From smallest life '*ant*' to biggest life '*brahmaa*') This enabler is different from the enabled or bodies (*aatmaa* is different from *anaatmaa*). All movable and immovable bodies in the universe have a life cycle of birth and death - *jaatasya hi dhruvo mrutyuh*. Once born shall perish. *Aatmaa* is independent of the birth and death cycle. *Shrushti* is *trigunaatmakam* and *paancha bhautikam*. All that is enabled are created through the five elements; they exist with three Gunas.

Goal of human: *jeevan mukti* i.e. relief from the cycle of birth and death i.e. *moksha. Pravrutti maarga* and *nivrutti maarga* are the two ways to reach *moksha*.

Principle to reach the Goal: Perceive *reality* i.e. to cultivate experiencing *reality* everywhere in the universe by following *karma yoga - nishkaama karma* with *sharanaagati*.

Reaching the Goal is self-directive - Aatmaanaa Atmaanam uddharet

Bhagavadgeetaa is the key to Vedic philosophy, personality development for human and mind sciences.

अकृत्यं नैव कर्तव्यं प्राणत्यागेऽपि संस्थिते । न च कृत्यं परित्याज्यमेष धर्मः सनातनः ॥

akrutyam naiva kartavyam praanatyaagopi samsthite | na cha krutyam parityaajyamesha dharmah sanaatanah || - Panchatantra - Mitra laabham - Shloka 4.41
